ACCEPTANCE TO WSE IS COMPETITIVE.

To qualify, you must have completed your junior year of college and have:

- Intention to intern in the New York City metro area with a financial services firm or within a financial function at a non-financial firm
- A minimum cumulative G.P.A. of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- An interest in exploring a career in finance or business. The program is also open to students pursuing careers in Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM).
- A fully complete application containing all requested information
