WSE is a series of events hosted by top firms and companies for the purpose of professional and personal development as well as networking for a competitively selected group of rising college seniors working as summer interns in the New York metropolitan area. This year's enthusiastic class of 44 summer interns represent 25 prestigious colleges and universities* and 21 highly respected firms, many of whom are President's Circle members.
